Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

This past Sunday I shared with you that I have received a Call from Lamb of God Lutheran Church, in Flower Mound, Texas to serve as their Senior Pastor. So, the question has come to me several times since that announcement, "How does a Call process work?"

What it most definitely is not is send-out-resumes, secure an interview, and get-a-job process. Some church bodies work that way. It is also not a top-down, we'll-tell-you-where-you're-going process. Overall, any congregation can call any rostered pastor. Rostered means that a pastor is in good standing within the District and Synod. There are different ways of getting names, but generally, if the pastor is rostered, he is eligible for a Call. In that way, this process is very congregational.

In the LCMS, the district presidents are usually involved in the call process of congregations in their districts. So, what makes a Lutheran congregation's call different than, say, a Baptist or non-denominational congregation? A Call in our LCMS is not a congregation "hiring" the pastor. While a Call comes from the congregation, it is also, and ultimately, a Divine Call from God to serve His people in that place. Thus, it is God who, through means, as He always does, Calls His pastors from one place to another.

Right now my path forward is, "as clear as mud." I genuinely love serving the Lord in this place, and my family loves Bella Vista, yet God saw fit to have this Call come. So, whenever a pastor receives a new Call, the Lord of the Church provides an excellent opportunity for a pastor to consider his God given abilities and to reflect upon the question of where he may best put those abilities to use in Christ's kingdom. Each new Call prompts the need in pastors to evaluate both the current Call in which they serve, as well as the new Call received.

This decision making process is usually not a process of choosing between making a right decision or a wrong decision. It is more the process of choosing between one good place the Lord has previously Called a pastor to serve, or choosing the other good place the Lord most recently has Called a pastor to serve. As a result of receiving a new Call, pastors gather data, seek advice, turn to the Lord in prayer, and come to a decision trusting that God will bless this decision making process.

Again I ask for your continuing prayers and please do share with me anything you think may be helpful.
